### Lead Teacher in a Group Center

- Fundamentals of Infant & Toddler Care\*  
\* If you plan to care for children under age 2.

### Assistant Teacher in a Group Center

- Introduction to the Child Care Profession
- Fundamentals of Infant & Toddler Care\*  
\* If you plan to care for children under age 2.

### Group Center Director (50 or fewer children)

- Introduction to the Child Care Profession
- Skills & Strategies for the Child Care Teacher
- And within one year of assuming the position, one course in the WI Child Care Administrator Credential\*

### Group Center Director (51 or more children)

- Introduction to the Child Care Profession
- Skills & Strategies for the Child Care Teacher
- 4 related early childhood education college credits
- Within 3 years of assuming the position, completing the Registry Administrator Credential\*

## Additional Required Training

- Abusive Head Trauma Prevention Training (AHT), Sudden Infant Death Training (SIDS), and Child Abuse & Neglect (CAN) are required for all Child Care Professionals working with children under the age of 5. Note: AHT, SIDS, and CAN are included in Introduction to the Child Care Profession and Fundamentals of Infant & Toddler Care (completed after July 1, 2005).
- Infant/Child CPR with AED training: required for all child care programs. *(Must be updated every 2 years)*
